

Social Media Acceptable Use Policy.



Bridgnorth Cycling Club understand the importance of using technology to communicate and share information with all our members.

However, whilst we encourage online communication, we would like to provide our members, parents, volunteers and club officials with a set of guidelines for appropriate online conduct.

We ask that you take a few minutes to read through this policy. (Where appropriate, we would encourage parents to discuss the importance of this policy with their child/children).

- Each member will be responsible for their behaviour and/or use of language when posting on social networking sites and communication apps.
- Each member will be respectful of others and will not use social networking or the internet to send anyone material that could be considered threatening, offensive, upsetting, bullying or illegal.
- Each member must understand that they will be held responsible for re-posting material considered to be in breach of British Cycling's values, even in circumstances where they have not authored the original post.
- Each member will understand that Bridgnorth Cycling Club has a complaints procedure and social networking sites/communication apps are not the forum for venting personal grievances.
- Each member will not post any confidential or sensitive information about any Bridgnorth Cycling Club members, volunteers, or officials.
- Each member will not share my passwords with anyone else.
- Each member will not post or share images without permission.

Each member should understand that these statements are designed to uphold the values of British Cycling and Bridgnorth Cycling Club and any concern/complaint about comments posted on social networking sites and communication apps may be reported to Bridgnorth Cycling Club and British Cycling.
