Groups must not exceed 6 riders (2 if it is intended to ride into Wales). If more than 6 riders attend the meeting point, it will be necessary for multiple groups to be formed. Groups should either ride different routes or leave at least 5 minutes between each group leaving.			1	5	5		Procedure for first phase recommencement of Club riding
Riding	Virus Transmission	3	5	15	Riders must maintain social distancing of at least 1m plus at all times during a ride. Riders should be prepared to move to a single file formation when road conditions require it. Riders should consider wearing a face covering to limit the transmission of airborne particles and should practice good hygiene including moving to the back of the bunch to clear their throat or to blow their nose. Riders should not share food or drink and should avoid contact with another riders bike or equipment.
